## WRIT PETITION No. 582 of 2022

## **ORDER:-**

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Standing Counsel for APSRTC.

The grievance of the petitioner in the present Writ Petition, in short, is that no action has been taken by the respondents on the petitioner's representation dated 19.08.2021, with regard to service benefits, so far.

The learned counsel for the petitioner while reiterating the contentions raised in the Writ Petition submits that due to non consideration of the petitioner's representation, the petitioner is subjected to hardship. He submits that unless a specific direction is issued to the respondent Nos.2 and 4 to take expeditious action on the said representation, the petitioner would be further subjected to serious prejudice.

Considering the submissions made, this Court without going into merits of the case, is inclined to dispose of the Writ Petition with a direction to the respondent Nos.2 and 4 to take necessary action on the petitioner's representation and pass appropriate orders thereon, in accordance with Law and applicable Rules and Regulations, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
