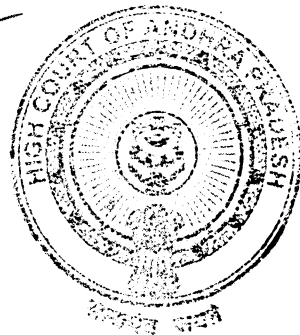

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to declare the high handed action of the respondents No. 2 to 4 illegal arbitrary and set aside the impugned Notice No. Lr.No.DB/ATO/F W-22(A) 455 M Dt. 18-07-2019 issued by the Respondent No.2 consequently direct to the respondents not to Dismantle/ Demolish the slab culvert on the Miramiacodu Minor drain at Km 1.850 in Bhimavaram Town, West Godavari District.
