**ORDER:** 

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned Government Pleader for Home, appearing for the

respondents.

The written instructions given to the learned

Government Pleader for Home by the 4th respondent are

taken on file. It is stated that after receipt of a complaint the

matter was looked into and an enquiry was conducted.

Thereafter, realizing that it is a civil dispute the 3rd

respondent addressed a letter to the District Legal Services

Authority, Kadapa, to resolve the issue. The 3rd respondent

also reported to his superiors that no action is necessary to

be taken on the complaint. It is asserted that this is purely

a civil dispute and that the police neither interfered with the

same nor they threatened the petitioner. Therefore, nothing

further survives for adjudication.

Noting the above submission, the Writ Petition is

disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
