But in the instant case, the Special Commissioner of Intermediate Education/ 2nd respondent herein issued the impugned proceedings dated 18.02.2021, approving the name of the 8th respondent as Secretary and Correspondent of the subject college.</p> <p>Clause 12 of Section 2 of the Andhra Pradesh Education Act, 1982 defines the term competent authority.
