THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE NINALA JAYASURYA WRIT PETITION No.2251 OF 2021

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue.

- 2. The grievance of the petitioners in the present writ petition, in short, is that despite making an applications in Form 6-A on 15.12.2020 for issuance of Pattadar Passbooks and Title Deeds and to mutate the names of the petitioners in the Land Revenue Records in respect of the respective lands in question, no action is taken by the 4th respondent so far.
- 3. As the applications of the petitioners are required to be considered by the 4th respondent, this Court, without going into the merits of the matter, is inclined to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the 4th respondent to take necessary action on the petitioners' applications dated 15.12.2020 strictly in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
- 4. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No order as to costs. As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
