(National Highway No.167 in the stretch of land from Km.62.700 to km.70.000) By-pass road in Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh, without issuing proper notices to the public including the petitioners.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contend that the said notification was published in two newspapers i.e., HANS India and Andhra Prabha which are having only 10 and 50 circulations respectively. Due to that reason, the petitioners could not know about that notification to ventilate their grievances by following the due process of law.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, in the prima facie opinion of this Court, interest of the petitioners has to be protected as in the approved alignment, the petitioners constructed residential houses and without giving any opportunity to them, if the respondents are proceeded with the notification dated 16.11.2022, definitely, the petitioners have to suffer irreparable loss.

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to maintain status-quo in all respects for a period of four (04) weeks. DEV,J **Note: Issue CC today.** B/o mnr
