# THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE RAVI CHEEMALAPATI WRIT PETITION NO.1879 OF 2023

#### **ORDER:**

The present Writ Petition is filed seeking the following relief:
"....to declare the action of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in issuing the
Gazette Notification No.5100, dated 16.11.2022 in
respect of the land in an extent of 0.8820000 (Hectare) in
Sy.No.344-2, in an extent of 0.25900000 (Hectare) in Sy.
No.340 (Sl.Nos.25 & 26 of Gazette Notification) for the
purpose of construction of Adoni (National Highway No.167
in the stretch of land from km.62.700 to km.70.000) byepass road in Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh as illegal and
arbitrary."

- 2. Heard Smt V. Sesha Kumari, learned counsel for petitioners and Sri S S Varma, learned Standing counsel for respondent nos. 2 & 3, and Sri N. Hari Nath, learned counsel for 1<sup>st</sup> respondent and learned Government Pleader for Revenue for 4<sup>th</sup> respondent.
- Sri S S Varma, learned Standing counsel for respondent nos. 2 &
   and Sri N. Hari Nath, learned counsel for 1<sup>st</sup> respondent and learned
   Government Pleader for Revenue for 4<sup>th</sup> respondent collectively

submitted that, in similar set of facts this Court passed orders on 10.04.2023 in W.P.No.8502/2023 and on 10.03.2023 W.P.No.3316/2023, and in the same lines, this case also be considered.

- To the said submission, learned counsel for the petitioners 4. reported no objection.
- 5. Taking submissions of the learned counsel on the both sides into consideration with their consent and as no purpose would be served in keeping this Writ Petition pending, this Court is inclined to dispose of this Writ Petition in terms of orders passed on 10.04.2023 in W.P.No.8502/2023 and on 10.03.2023 in W.P.No.3316/2023, at admission stage.

Accordingly, the petitioners are at liberty to submit their objections and make fresh representation, as per Section 3-C of the National Highways Act, 1956 within two (2) weeks from the date of receipt of this order and on receiving such objections, the 4th respondent-authority shall dispose of the same in accordance with law and communicate the same to the petitioners. Till such exercise is completed, the respondents are directed not to take any coercive steps pursuant to the Gazette Notification No.5100, dated 16.11.2022 in respect of the land in an extent of 0.8820000(Hectare) in Sy.No.344-2,

in an extent of 0.25900000 (Hectare) in Sy. No.340 (Sl.Nos.25 & 26 of Gazatte Notification.)

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.


