## THE HON'BLE Dr.JUSTICE K. MANMADHA RAO Writ Petition No.1791 Of 2023

## ORDER: -

This Writ Petition is filed, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents in not disposing of the Petitioner's representations dated 23/06/2019, 09/11/2022 and 24-09-2021, and not granting the benefits of continuity of service from the date of removal, i.e. from 28/11/2001 to the date of re-instatement 27/06/2014 and not giving service benefits, pay fixation, attendant benefits, increments, promotions etc., as illegal, arbitrary, violation of Principles of Natural Justice, violation of Articles 14, 19(1)(g) and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the attendant benefits, increments, promotions etc.,

- 2. Heard Mr. P.S.P. Suresh Kumar, learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Services-I, appearing for the Respondent No. 1, and Mr. V.R. Reddy Kovvuri appearing for the Respondent Nos. 2 to 4. Perused the material available on record.
- 3. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that, suffice if a direction is given to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to dispose of the representation dated 09.11.2022, in accordance with law, by stipulating the time period.

4. Learned Counsel for the Respondent Nos.2 to 4, does not refute

the said submission.

5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances and without

touching the merits of the case, the respondent No.2 is directed to

consider and pass appropriate orders on the representation dated

09.11.2022, in accordance with law, within a period of (06) six weeks

from the date of receipt of the order.

6. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the admission

stage. No costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall

stand closed.
