Government Pleader for Roads & Buildings Department, it would appear that there is a dispute between the Villagers with regard to construction of culvert. While one set of the Villagers state that there is a culvert in existence for the last hundred (100) years and unless a new culvert is constructed at Punthala Musalamma Temple, their houses would be affected whereas the other set of Villagers are opposing construction on the ground that if the culvert is constructed, their houses would be affected.

Be that as it may. As the petitioners have complaint/representation made а through Spandana Programme, this Court is of the considered view that the matter requires intervention by the respondent No.2/District Collector for resolving the issue. Therefore, there shall be a direction to the respondent No.2 to take immediate action on the petitioners' complaint/representation dated 22.1.2024 within a period of two (2) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Till such time, construction of cement road shall not be proceeded with.
