By Order dated 25.01.2023, this Court had taken into account the various deficiencies and the fact that the Authorities have placed various Colleges under Zero Admission Category.</p> <p>3. Learned Counsel appearing for the Writ Petitioners have informed this Court that the first Notification was issued scheduling for online counseling in the month of October, 2022. Thereafter, the date for counseling was rescheduled to 25.01.2023. In the meantime,</p>	

		<p>while some of the Colleges have approached this Court and had obtained Interim Orders to the effect that the respective Colleges shall be admitted for counseling, the Official Respondents have rescheduled the date of counseling to 16.02.2023.</p> <p>4. Learned Counsel for the Writ Petitioners has also drawn the attention of this Court to the fact that in the present batch of Writ Petitions, the Official Respondents have once again passed certain Orders, styled as 'Speaking Orders'.</p> <p>5. It is further submitted that such 'Speaking Orders' are self-same Orders that were passed earlier against the respective Colleges and that there is nothing new.</p> <p>6. Be that as it may, since this Court, as interim measure, has already permitted several Colleges to participate in the counseling scheduled to take place on 16.02.2023, this Court does not find any reason to discriminate the present set of Writ Petitioners.</p> <p>7. In view of what is stated herein above, this Court deems it appropriate to issue the following directions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Writ Petitioners' Colleges shall be permitted to participate in the counseling scheduled on 16.02.2023 by including their names in the web counseling of EdCET-2022. ii. This exercise of including and displaying the names of Writ Petitioners to enable them to participate in the EdCET-2022 counseling as per the schedule dates,
