THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE D.V.S.S.SOMAYAJULU WRIT PETITION No.3134 of 2020

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking to direct the respondents, to dispose of the representation of the petitioner, dated 26.10.2019.
