The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Criminal Petition and the memorandum of grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Venkata Mayur, Advocate for the Petitioner(s), and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent No.1, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

"Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to the 2nd respondent by Registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service into the Registry.

2. A perusal of the complaint made by the defacto complainant dated 3.2.2022 shows that it is contrary to the orders passed by the Competent Civil Court ie., Junior Civil Judge, Allagadda in I.A.No. 777/2021 in O.S No.369/2021.

3. The 1st petitioner filed the said Suit. The competent Civil Court has considered the record and granted Injunction in favour of the petitioner on 22.09.2021. Though the injunction is in favour of the petitioner, being a third party, the present complaint is made against the petitioner.

4. Considering the submissions made and perusal of record, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.18/2022 on the file of Changalamarri Police Station, Kurnool District.
