	23.02.2022	<p><u>AVSS,J & RC,J</u></p> <p>Smt.B.V.Aparna Lakshmi, learned Standing Counsel, takes notice for respondent Nos.3 and 7.</p> <p>In the present Writ Petition, petitioner herein, who is a retired employee in Panchayat Raj Department, is seeking enforcement of the order dated 19.02.2016, passed by the Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal in O.A.No.2344 of 2015. By way of the said order, the Tribunal, while setting aside the order impugned in the Original Application, directed the respondents to consider the name of the applicant for pension and pensionary benefits, including gratuity and to release the same within four (4) months, from the date of receipt of the order.</p> <p>Subsequently, while referring to the information furnished by the Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Praja Parishad and the orders of the Government vide G.O.Rt.No.1797, Panchayat Raj and Rural Development Department, dated 19.11.2013, issued by the State Government, in similar circumstances, the Director, Panchayat Raj and Rural Development issued letter No.671402/DPR &RD/C1/2015, dated 05.03.2019. In the said letter, the Director also specifically stated that the Chief</p>	

	<p>Executive Officer submitted a report for sanction of pensionary benefits, gratuity and other benefits to the petitioner.</p> <p>Subsequently, alleging willful disobedience of the order passed in O.A.No.2344 of 2015, on the part of the respondents, petitioner herein approached this Court by way of filing C.C.No.1717 of 2021.</p> <p>According to the petitioner, pending contempt case, the respondents herein paid a sum of Rs.35,828/- in the month of December, 2021.
