Whereas the petitioner has presented under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, the above case their his counsel Sri G. ORDER:-

"The 1st respondent - Sri M. Hari Narayan, appeared online.

A memo is filed on behalf of 2nd respondent stating that notice in Form-I was issued to the 2nd respondent to appear before this Court on 04.05.2021 but the matter was not listed on that day and the matter is listed today suddenly. Sri Suresh Kumar Reddy Kalava, learned counsel appearing for the 2nd respondent submits that due to ill health, the 2nd respondent is unable to attend before this Court today and requested to dispense with the presence of the 2nd respondent.
