Therefore, a representation dated 24.07.2022 has been made to the respondents and the same was also not considered.</p> <p>Learned counsel contended that it would suffice for the time being if a direction is given to the respondent authorities to consider and dispose of the representation made by the petitioner in a time bound manner, pending consideration of the writ petition.</p> <p>Learned Assistant Government Pleader submitted that the representation is of the year 2022 and he has no instructions whether the respondent office had received the said representation or not.
