ORDER:

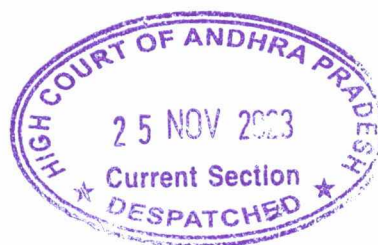
