01.	11.03.2025	<p><u>HN, J</u></p> <p>The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are arraigned as Accused Nos.1 and 2, in C.C.No.154 of 2024, on the file Ramabhadrapuram Police Station, Vizianagaram District, for the alleged offences under Section(s) 318(4), 336(3), 338, 340(2) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short, "BNS").</p> <p>It is submitted that the allegations, even as per the compliant, would not imply that the petitioners have committed forgery of a purported document. Even as per the complaint, the de facto complainant has stated that a document signed by them from the USA was sent via whatsapp to the petitioners.</p> <p>The learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the complaint is vague and appears to have been filed out of vengeance.</p> <p>It is further submitted that the complaint was filed solely based on an apprehension when the 2nd respondent was in India.</p>
