This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the following relief:

"....to issue appropriate writ order or direction particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of respondents in not promoting the petitioner to the cadre of Hostel Welfare Officer Gradel though she is fully eligible and qualified in the year 2008 itself While effecting promotion in 2008 at roster point 8 unqualified candidate was promoted and at roster point 25 petitioners junior who is at Serial No 34 in the seniority list This action of respondents is illegal arbitrary being voilative of Rule 22A and Rule 33 and Rule 37 of Andhra Pradesh State and subordinate Service Rules 1966 and Articles 14 16 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to affect notional promotion to petitioner since 2008 with all consequential benefits and arrears of salary and pass...."
