	25.04.2025	<p><b><u>TCDS,J</u></b></p> <p>It is the case of the petitioner that her husband was assigned land admeasuring an extent of Ac.2.10 cents in Sy.No.17232 of Konerukuppa Village, Saanthipuram Mandal, Chittoor District, by the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, <i>vide</i> proceedings No.250-4-1399, dated 05.06.1990. It is further case of the petitioner that the name of her husband was entered into the revenue records and pattadar passbooks were issued in his favour over the subject land. While so, the original assignee/ husband of the petitioner was died on 31.03.2022. Consequently, the petitioner came into possession of the subject land. It is contended by the petitioner that the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, without issuing any notice, tried to dispossess the petitioner from the subject land, and upon enquiry, the petitioner came to know that an order dated 20.09.2024, was passed by the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, whereby and whereunder the assignment made in favour of her husband was cancelled. 	<p>present writ petition is filed.</p> <p>On the other hand, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue would submit that the order under challenge was passed after following the due procedure contemplate under law, and in fact, notices were also issued to the original assignee on 02.01.2024, 22.01.2024 and 12.02.2024.</p> <p>The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the original assignee/husband of the petitioner was expired on 31.03.2022, proof of evidence in the same, she filed death certificate of the original assignee along with the writ petition. Therefore, the contention of the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, that notices were served on the original assignee, cannot be believed.</p> <p>Taking into consideration of the submissions made by both the parties, there shall be interim suspension of order of the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, <i>vide</i> ROC.No.A/76/2024, dated 20.09.2024.</p> <p>Post the matter after Summer Vacation, 2025.</p> <p>In the meantime, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, is directed to file counter affidavit.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">_____ TCDS,J</p>
