ORDER:-

The petitioner, who has a quarry lease for Colour Granite, had received a Demand Notice bearing No.2120/Q2/C.G/2010, dated 24.12.2020, issued by the 3rd respondent, demanding an amount of Rs.2,19,45,140/-. Aggrieved by the said order, the petitioner had approached the 1st respondent, by way of a revision. This revision was dismissed by the 1st respondent by No.9323/M.I(1)/2021, bearing dated Aggrieved by the said order of dismissal, the petitioner has approached this Court.

- Heard Sri G.Raja Babu, learned counsel for the 2. petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Mines and Geology.
- 3. A perusal of the said order shows that the revisional authority has not given any reasons for dismissing the revision application of the petitioner.
- 4. Non furnishing of reasons in a quasi judicial order of this nature is a clear case of violation of principles of natural justice requiring the interdiction of the Court.
- Accordingly, this writ petition is allowed by setting aside the impugned Memo bearing No.9323/M.I(1)/2021, dated 22.11.2021 and the revision is remanded back to the 1st respondent, to consider all the objections of the petitioner, and to pass an order giving reasons.
