Now by orders dated 07.07.2023 passed in M.P.No.11 of 2017, claim of respondent with respect to the wages for the period from 13.03.1997 to 18.12.2007 have been ordered to be paid along with interest at the rate of 9% which is assailed in the present writ petition.
