Request for adjournment is also made by number of counsel appearing for the petitioners in other cases.</p> <p>Mr. S. Sri Ram, learned Advocate General, submits that if the cases are to be adjourned today, having regard to the COVID-19 situation, it will be appropriate to take them up for hearing in the month of November, 2021.</p> <p>The learned counsel for the petitioners appearing today also agree that the cases may be taken up in the month of November, 2021.</p> <p>However, Mr. Prabhunath Vasireddy, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners in some of the cases, submits that the cases may be taken up after two weeks.</p> <p>Having regard to the broad consensus arrived at the bar, we deem it appropriate to direct listing of these cases for hearing on 15.11.2021.</p> <p>We request the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners to work out a schedule amongst themselves to finalise the seriatim in which they will advance their arguments, so as to facilitate day-to-day hearing of the cases without any interruption.
