1.	02.05.2025	<p><u>TCDS,J</u></p> <p>The present writ petition is filed questioning the notice dated 10.03.2025 issued by the 3rd respondent.</p> <p>It is the case of the petitioner that the unofficial respondents filed an appeal seeking to cancel the pattadar passbooks issued in favour of the petitioner.</p> <p>This Court in <i>Ratnamma v. Revenue Divisional Officer</i>¹, held that an appeal under Section 5(5) of the Act 26 of 1971 is not maintainable as against the issuance of pattadar passbooks.</p> <p>In view of the same, there shall be an interim suspension of notice dated 10.03.2025, issued by the 3rd respondent.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on unofficial respondents through registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry.</p>
