

**HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE RAKESH KUMAR**

**WRIT PETITION No.16956 OF 2020**

(Proceedings taken up through video conferencing)

**ORDER:**

1. Heard Sri Balaji Medamalli, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Sri G.L.Nageswara Rao, learned Government Pleader for Revenue.
2. The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, with a prayer to restrain respondent Nos.3 and 4 from disturbing/dispossessing the petitioner from his peaceful possession over the property to an extent of Ac.5.65 cents each in Survey No.2580 of S.Upparapalli Village, Railway Kodur Mandal, Kadapa District, without following due process of law.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, without following any due process of law, the respondents, particularly respondent Nos.3 and 4 are trying to dispossess the petitioner.
4. With the consent of learned counsel for both the parties, the Writ Petition is being disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.3 and 4 not to disturb/dispossess the petitioner from the property in question, without following due process of law.
5. Accordingly, with the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
6. As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
