Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent in constituting the Enquiry Commission in pursuant to the Memorandum vide Memo No.AKNU/Estt./2019-20/01, dt.04-12-2019 and proceeding with the enquiry before commencing the trial in Criminal case arising in Cr.No.489/2019 on the file of the Rajanagaram Police Station, Rajamahendravaram as arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the provisions prescribed under A.P. Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1991 in the interest of justice.
