

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.SATYANARAYANA MURTHY

WRIT PETITION NO.15797 OF 2021

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following relief:-

“....to issue a Writ Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, to declare the inaction of the Respondent Nos.2 to 4 authorities to delete the petitioner property lands from the prohibited list of 4th respondent in Sy.N.1-4 for an extent of Ac.4.00 cents in Sy.No.1-4 Tummulakonda Ramachandrapuram Village, Meliaputti Mandal, Srikakulam District by disposing the petitioner online application vide No.TATTA012000047751 dated 07.02.2020 is illegal, arbitrary and violation of Articles 14,21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and violation of Section 22(A) of Stamps and Registration Act and also violation of the principles of natural justice and consequently direct Respondent Nos.2 to 4 to dispose of the petitioner online application vide No.TATTA012000047751 dated 07.02.2020”

2. Though the petitioner made several allegations against the respondents, during hearing, Sri T.Tejeswara Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner limited his request to dispose of the Mee Seva Application No. TATTA012000047751 dated 07.02.2020 submitted by the petitioner, without touching the merits of the case.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents readily agreed to dispose of the Mee Seva Application No. TATTA012000047751 dated 07.02.2020 submitted by the petitioner, if any, pending with the respondent-authorities.

4. Recording the submissions of the learned Government Pleader for Revenue, I need not decide the truth or otherwise of the allegations made in the petition. This Court is conscious that no such direction be issued, in view of the judgment of the Apex Court in "*The Government of India v. P.Venkatesh*¹", wherein the Apex Court held that such orders may make for a quick or easy disposal of cases in overburdened adjudicatory institutions. But, they do not serve to the cause of justice. As the learned counsel for the petitioner himself requested to issue a direction to dispose of the Mee Seva Application No TATTA012000047751 dated 07.02.2020 submitted by the petitioner, I find no other alternative, except to issue such direction.

5. In the result, the Writ Petition is disposed of, directing the respondent authorities to dispose of the Mee Seva Application No. TATTA012000047751 dated 07.02.2020 submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law, within two (02) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous application, pending, if any, shall also stand closed.
