Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 3rd respondent in issuing the impugned Memo No. CEE/O&M/Dr.NTTPS/Admn/C3/F6/D.No.1279/14 dt.4-6-2014 rejecting the request made by the petitioners and others for revision of their seniority,

without considering the fact that at the time of promotion of the petitioners to the post of Junior Plant Attendants the seniority was not counted on par with others, as being illegal, arbitrary and unjust and consequently set aside the same, by directing the respondents to revise the seniority of the petitioners by counting their seniority to the post of Junior Plant Attendant from the date of their initial appointment as Man Mazdoors, and to grant such other relief or reliefs as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.
