

SMT JUSTICE T. RAJANI

WRIT PETITION No.12559 of 2019

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking to declare the action of the 2nd respondent in cancelling the social status certificate issued to the petitioner, vide proceedings in R.C.No.548/2014-C1, dated 10.07.2015, which was contrary to Chapter XV of issue of Community, Nativity and Date of Birth Certificate Rules, 1997, vide G.O.Ms.No.58, dated 12.05.1997, as illegal.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader appearing for respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to cancellation of Social Status Certificate, the petitioner preferred appeal before the 1st respondent, dated 24.07.2019 and the same is pending.

4. Hence, in view of the above, this court deems it fit to direct the 1st respondent to dispose of the appeal of the petitioner, pending before it and pass appropriate orders, within a period of six (6) weeks, from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In the mean time, no action shall be taken by the respondents 3 to 5, on the cancellation of social status certificate issued to the petitioner.

5. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, in
the writ petition shall stand closed.
