WRIT PETITION No.20795 of 2020

ORDER:

Sri R.Rajasekhar Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Sri K.Sajid, learned counsel representing Sri E.V.Jagannatha Rao, learned standing counsel for the respondent-Corporation. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services II represents respondents 2 and 4.

- 2. The petitioners, who worked as Work Inspectors earlier, sought implementation of the orders of the 3rd respondent in Rc.No.A6/A5/1205/OSWI/2019, dated 09.10.2020, to provide them necessary work. In fact, the proceedings, referred to above, stand in the nature of a communication addressed to the District Collector, Kadapa District, by the 3rd respondent. Inasmuch as permission is granted to the District Collector, Kadapa, to engage the services of eligible outsourced work inspectors, who worked earlier and retrenched for various reasons, there cannot be any difficulty to accede to the request of the petitioners.
- 3. Learned counsel appearing for the parties also referred to these facts and circumstances.
- 4. In the above circumstances, this writ petition is disposed of directing the 1st respondent to accept the services of the petitioners whenever necessary strictly in terms of the communication in Rc.No.A6/A5/1205/OSWI/2019, dated 09.10.2020, by the

 3^{rd} respondent to the 2^{nd} respondent without making any deviation and as per Rules in vogue. No costs.

As a sequel, pending miscellaneous petitiohns, if any, shall stand closed.
