WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri P.V Ramana presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus declaring the orders passed by the District Collector vide proceedings A1/130/2019 dt.25.6.2019 in transferring the petitioner to Konalova, Addatheegala Mandal, duly posting the unofficial respondent in the place of the petitioner, Mukunur Village, Chinturu Mandal, contrary to the ban imposed by the government and not paying the salary to the petitioner from July 2020 till this date as illegal and arbitrary and violates Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently declare that the petitioner is entitled to continue at his original place at Mukunur Gram Panchayat, Chinturu Mandal, and salary with interest @ 14 percent p.a. salary and consequential attendant benefits.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P.V. Ramana Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
