Station of Visakhapatnam at 02.30 pm. The revision petitioner is unable to speak and it is stated that he is suffering from paralysis. His son Sri V.Pavan Kumar is in attendance assisting his father.

On interaction with them, it is noticed that to engage a new counsel, they are unable to find out the earlier counsels so as to obtain no objection certificate. It is in these circumstances, the revision petitioner is appraised that he is entitled to have a legal aid counsel for which purpose, he could make an application before High Court, Legal Services Committee which would appoint a counsel for the revision petitioner. If such application is moved, the Secretary, High Court, Legal Services Committee should consider the same in accordance with the rules as quickly as possible.

In these circumstances, the escorting police are directed to produce the revision petitioner before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Visakhapatnam (formerly learned Chief

Metropolitan Magistrate, Visakhapatnam) and the revision petitioner on execution of personal bond for Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction the of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, released. The revision Visakhapatnam be petitioner is directed to undertake that he would instruct his counsel to appear and argue this revision without fail.
