Writ Petition No.3326 of 2012

Order:

This Writ Petition is filed questioning the orders dated 17.03.2009 passed in ID No.272 of 2005 by the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Anantapur.

The case of the petitioner, in brief, is that he was appointed as a Conductor in the 2nd respondent Corporation in the year 1980 and while he was conducting the bus bearing Registration NoAP10Z 8430 on the route Yemiganur-Kurnool on 09.03.2005 a check was exercised and a charge memo was issued to him alleging certain ticket and cash irregularities; subsequently, he was removed from service on 01.07.2005; the appeal and review petition filed by him were dismissed; aggrieved by the same, he filed ID No.272 of 2005 and the same was also dismissed by the impugned order dated 17.03.2009. Hence, the Writ Petition.

Today, when the matter came up for hearing, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the second respondent Corporation submits that if the petitioner makes an application for terminal benefits which he is entitled to, the Corporation would take appropriate action on the same. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would make such application.

In view of the same, if the petitioner files any application seeking terminal benefits which he is entitled to, the appropriate authority is directed to deal with the same and release the amounts which are due to the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible. It is made clear that if the petitioner is not entitled to the same, the appropriate authority is directed to pass a reasoned order and communicate the same to the petitioner.
