Sriram, learned Advocate General, submits that payments in terms of the orders passed by the learned single Judge had been made till 31.12.2020. The aforesaid statement is opposed by a number of counsel stating that the order of the learned single Judge is not complied with in its entirety and some deductions had been made without indicating the purpose for which such deductions had been made. Learned Advocate General further submits that so far as the first quarter of 2021 is concerned, it is expected that the payments will be made in terms of the order of the learned single Judge by 31.05.2021. He has also submitted that he will file a comprehensive affidavit indicating the manner of payment, including the purpose for which the deductions have been effected, so as to give a clear picture of payments made.
