## THE HON'BLE Dr.JUSTICE K. MANMADHA RAO Writ Petition No.25430 of 2022

## **ORDER:-**

This Writ Petition is filed, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking to declare the action of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in passing the removal order dated 25.8.2021 on the ground that the criminal case in Crime No.179/2019 was registered against the petitioner under Section 362, 448, 323, 506 IPC of Garugubilli P.S., Vizianagram, as illegal and arbitrary, and consequently directing the respondents to reinstate the petitioner into service, as he was acquitted in the criminal case.

- 2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Services-I.
- 3. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that suffice it if a direction is given to the Additional Director General of Police, Vijayawada / 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to dispose of the representation dated 06.07.2022 of the petitioner..
- 4. Learned Government Pleader for Services-I does not refute the said submission.
- 5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances and without touching the merits of the case, the Additional Director General of Police, Vijayawada / 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent is directed to pass appropriate orders on the representation dated 06.07.2022 of the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of (06) six weeks from the date of receipt of the order.

6. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage. No costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
