1.	25.09.2024	<p><u>KSR,J & SRK,J</u></p> <p><i>(per Hon'ble Sri Justice K.Suresh Reddy)</i></p> <p><u>Crl.A.No.607 of 2024</u></p> <p>Admit.</p> <p><u>I.A.No.1 of 2024</u></p> <p>The present application is filed by the petitioners/appellants/A.2 & A.8 under Section 389 (1) of Cr.P.C., seeking their release on bail by suspending the sentence of imprisonment imposed by the learned IV Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge for Trial of Offences against women, Anantapuramu, <i>vide</i> S.C.No.487 of 2017, dated 19.09.2024, for the offence under Sections 346, 365 and 384 read with 34 IPC, pending the present Criminal Appeal before this Court.</p> <p>2. The learned counsel for the petitioners/A.2 & A.8 contended that the petitioners/A.2 & A.8 were convicted under Sections 346, 365 and 384 read with 34 IPC and they were sentenced to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for a period of two years for the offence under Section 346 IPC. They were further sentenced to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for a period of seven years and also to pay</p>	

		<p>fine of Rs.5000/- each, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for a period of five months for the offence under Section 365 IPC. The petitioners/A.2 & A.8 were further sentenced to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for a period of three years and also to pay fine of Rs.2000/- each, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for a period of three months for the offence under Section 384 IPC and all the sentences run concurrently.</p> <p>3. In view of the above facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners/A.2 & A.8 on bail by suspending the sentence of imprisonment imposed by the learned Sessions Judge pending the present Criminal Appeal.</p> <p>4. The petitioners/appellants/A.2 & A.8 are directed to be released on bail on their executing a personal bond for an amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) each with two (02) sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gooty.</p> <p>5.
