

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE CHEEKATI MANAVENDRANATH ROY**

**WRIT PETITION No.30563 OF 2022**

**ORDER:-**

This Writ Petition for mandamus is filed declaring the action of respondents 2 and 3 – police officials in making an effort to take coercive steps against the petitioner, who is shown as accused in Crime No.164 of 2022 of Maharanipeta Police Station, Visakhapatnam City, as illegal and consequently sought direction to the police not to arrest the petitioner till the completion of investigation and charge sheet is filed.

When the Writ Petition came up for admission before the Court today, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing for respondent – police officials would submit that the petitioner has already filed an application for grant of anticipatory bail before this Court in Criminal Petition No.4863 of 2022 and this Court by order, dated 05.08.2022, has dismissed the said application and the said order is available at page No.153 of the material papers. Therefore, he would submit that when the application for anticipatory bail was already dismissed by this Court that the petitioner cannot again seek the same relief by way of invoking writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the Writ Petition.

Permission is accorded.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

Miscellaneous Petitions, if any pending, in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
