Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus, to declare the proceedings of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent passed in ROC No. B4/54/2017 dated 1.10.2021 wherein an where under restricting to pay leave salary for the period 21.4.2017 to 21.2.2018, and disallowing for the period from 22.2.2018 to 31.3.2021 treated it as extraordinary leave instead of releasing full pay salary, with increments and the other benefits appended to the Post amounts to erroneous, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 311 of Constitution of India, besides being contrary to fundamental rules and consequently direct the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to treat the suspension period is on duty in terms of Fundamental Rule 54 A (3) and release full salary, with increments and all other benefits appended to the post forthwith in the interest of justice.
