Seeking exception to an order dated 22.07.2016 passed by the learned Writ Court in CWJC No. 17117 of 2013 this appeal has been filed under Clause 10 of the Letters Patent.

Matter pertains to renewal of the registration of Notary under the Notaries Act, 1952 (for short 'the Act') and the right of the petitioner for renewal of his registration. The learned Writ Court after considering the submission made has found that there has been default on the part of the petitioner. Because of the failure on part of the petitioner to deposit the renewal fee within the statutory period, the



learned Writ Court refused to interfere into the matter.

We have considered the reasons indicated by the learned Writ Court and we see no reason to interfere into the matter warranting reconsideration.

The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
