No. 2989/2004</u></p> <p>By this petition under section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No. 980/04 under section 406/420 IPC, P.S. Parshant Vihar.</p> <p>On 27.11.2004, petitioner No. 4 (Ms. Shikha Nagpal) lodged a complaint, alleging therein that on the basis of false representation of the petitioners, she got admission in the institute being run by the petitioner Nos. 1 to 3 and deposited a sum of Rs.30,000/-. It was alleged that petitioners were running only a distant learning course, and she was cheated by them. It is submitted that the complaint was lodged on some misunderstanding and the matter has been settled. Investigations are still in progress. Parties are present in person. Petition is duly supported by affidavits of both the parties. Learned APP for the State seeks permission to file Status Report. Let the same be taken on record.</p> <p>Looking into the nature of allegations and the fact that matter has been settled between the parties, petition is allowed.
