Heard Mr. R Ali, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. H Gupta, learned CGC for the Union of India.

In a selection process for Constable, General Duty, the petitioner had participated and claims that he was successful in the initial physical test and also in the subsequent written test and medical examination. Accordingly, as per Annexure-8 declaration of force allocation, the name of the petitioner finds under Sl.No.30070, but in spite of such force allocation no appointment has been given to the petitioner.

Information had been obtained under the RTI Act that the petitioner was erroneously declared fit in the DME(Medical Booklet) although it was informed by the CRPF that he was actually unfit.

The learned CGC shall produce the records of the medical test performed on the petitioner.

Issue notice, returnable by four weeks.

Extra copies be furnished to the learned CGC within 3(three) days.

In the interim, it is provided that 1(one) post of Constable, General Duty, in CISF where a post was allocated to the petitioner shall be kept vacant.
