Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Prohibition by declaring the action of the Respondent No.2 in issuing Notice to the Petitioner University vide Reference No.83/MSEFC/2021 dated 29.01.2021 and further Notice dated 09.02.2022 as violative to the procedure contemplated U/s.
