Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, by declaring the action of the respondents particularly the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in not considering the petitioner for counseling and admission into MBBS UG course under Category-C in NRI Quota for the academic year 2021-22 by receiving the requisite fees as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents to consider and include the name of the petitioner in the counseling for admission into MBBS UG course under category-C in NRI quota for the academic year 2021-22.

**WRIT PETITION No. 13864 of 2022**

**ORDER:** *(per Justice A.Rajasheker Reddy)*

This writ petition is filed for the following relief;

“to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly in the nature of writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents particularly 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in not considering the petitioner for counseling and admission into MBBS UG course under Category 'C' in NRI quota for the academic year 2021-22, as illegal and arbitrary and consequently to direct respondents to consider and include the name of the petitioner for admission into MBBS UG course under category “C” for the academic year 2021-22.”

Heard learned counsel for petitioner who submits that the *lis* in the writ petition is squarely covered by order dated 15.02.2022 passed by this Court in WP.No.8410 of 2022.

The same is not disputed by learned Assistant Government Pleader for Medical and Health appearing for 1<sup>st</sup> respondent and Sri A.Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing counsel for 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent-University.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and the orders passed by this court in the writ petition referred to above, and for the reasons alike, the present writ petition is disposed of as under:

“Petitioner is directed to approach respondent No.2 and submit her application along with necessary original certificates by

paying Rs.6,500/- (Rupees six thousand three hundred only) towards registration charges and Rs.7,500/- (rupees seven thousand five hundred only) towards service provider charges within three days from today.

On receipt of such application, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent shall consider the petitioner under B&C Category Management Quota for the academic year 2021-2022 for admission into MBBS UG course under Category C in NRI Quota, in the upcoming counseling, in accordance with law and take necessary action thereon. No order as to costs."

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
