Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that the Criminal Petition has become infructuous, as the matter has already been compromised between the parties.

2. Since the very criminal case in C.C.No.908 of 2014 on the file of Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Karimnagar registered for the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, is settled between the parties, the question of quashing the same does not arise.
