JUDGMENT: (per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Shri Nisar Ahmad Kakru)

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties at some length we could not persuade ourselves to record concurrence with the view taken by the learned single Judge in view of judicial pronouncement handed down in **Dr. M.Mohan Banu v. State of A.P., Commr. Of Police, Hyd. City** by this Court. However it was deemed appropriate to ask the respondent - writ petitioner as also the appellants to find out an alternative place by consensus where petitioner could assemble without disturbing peace, public tranquility and public order. In response thereto, Shri K. Rama Krishna Reddy, learned Senior Advocate proposed a place besides New Collectorate Office, Sanga-Reddy which is acceptable to the learned Advocate General. In that view of the matter, the writ petitioner shall file an application on or before

10-03-2011 by 11.00 AM for permission before the 2nd appellant - Superintendent of Police who shall have to pass appropriate orders at the earliest and till orders afresh are passed by the 2nd appellant the order of the learned single Judge shall remain in force. Needless to say that in case, the writ petitioner fails to file application by 11.00 AM on 10-03-2011, order of the learned single Judge appealed against shall stand set aside.

Writ appeal is disposed of.
