Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records relating to Crime No.166 of 2022 of Uppununthala Police Station, Nagarkurnool District, scrutinize its legality and quash the same as against the petitioner /Accused in the interest of justice.

**ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. by the petitioner/accused seeking to quash the proceedings against her in Crime No.166 of 2022 on the file of Uppununthala Police Station, Nagarkurnool District registered for the offences punishable under Section 420 of IPC.

2. Heard Mr.A.N.Raju, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent No.1 State.


3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the cause in the Criminal Petition does not survive for adjudication as the investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed before Judicial First Class Magistrate at Achampet vide C.C.No.16 of 2023. Therefore, he submits that no further orders are required in this Petition and seeks to dismiss this Criminal Petition as infructuous.

4. Recording the submissions of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous. Needless to mention, the petitioner is at liberty to work out the remedies as available under law.
