Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, by declaring the action of the 3rd Respondent in seizing the petitioners Seeds stock (Chilly and Cotton seeds varieties in packets, total worth of Rs.10,29,980/-) which were seized on 30-06-2021 in connection with the case in Crime No.117/2021 Raghunadhapalem Police Station, Khammam District, Telangana State, is illegal, improper and without any power of authority under law and violation of Article 19(1)(g) of the constitution of India and against the principals of natural justice and consequently to direct the respondent No 1 to 4 to release the petitioners Seeds stock (Chilly and Cotton seeds varieties in packets, total worth of Rs.10,29,980/-) which were seized on 30/06/2021 in connection with the case in Crime No.117/2021 Raghunadhapalem Police Station, Khammam District, Telangana State.
