ORDER:-

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner – accused under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Cr.No. 338 of 2013 of Jubilee Hills Police Station, Hyderabad registered for the offence punishable under Section 353 IPC.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and perused the material placed on record.

The allegation leveled against the petitioner is that he abused one Police Constable (PC 6469) of Jubilee Hills Police Station while he was performing his lawful duties on the mid-night of 07.07.2013.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the petitioner and his father are rowdies and the petitioner is not entitled to anticipatory bail.

Since it appears that while the *de facto* complainant, being the public servant, was performing his lawful duties, the petitioner abused him in filthy language and obstructed his official duty, I am of the view that the petitioner is not entitled to the discretionary remedy of anticipatory bail.

Hence, the Criminal Petition is dismissed.
