1. The learned Counsel for the Developer states that he has removed 100 hutment dewllers from the transit accommodation and now nearly 200 hutment dwellers are remaining to be removed.

- 2. The learned Counsel for the petitioners states that as per his instructions, out of 26 buildings, only four buildings are partially demolished. this statement, it is clear that the earlier statement made on 14th July, 2006 was not kept.
- 3. The learned Counsel for the Intervener/Developer again wants to make statement that he should be given four weeks time to remove the remaining hutment dwellers who are in the transit camp and get tenements vacated. It is directed that the Intervener/Developer shall file an affidavit within two weeks from today as to what he has done till today and how he is going to comply with the earlier statement made on 14th July, 2006 within four weeks from today.
