**ORDER :**

1. Present application has been filed for adding the applicant as party respondent in the Writ Petition. Present respondent Nos.1 to 3 have filed Writ Petition No.2240 of 2023.
2. Heard learned Advocate Mr. Thombre for Applicant, learned Advocate Mr. Temkar for respondent Nos.1 to 3, learned AGP Mr.

Tekale for Resp. Nos. 4 and 5 and learned Advocate Mr. Joshi for for Resp. No. 6.

3. Learned Advocate for the original petitioners has strong objection to allow the present Application.

4. The present applicant has come with the case that letter of intent has been issued in favour of the applicant by respondent No.4 and in view of the prayers in the Petition which are touching to the perspective plan as well as inviting proposals for issuing letter of intent (the then position) the present applicant is a necessary party.

5. The Application therefore stands allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause "(B)". Amendment to be carried out by the petitioner by tomorrow i.e. 9<sup>th</sup> February 2024.
