Heard Shri Naik, learned counsel for the petitioners, Shri Sambre, learned counsel for respondent No. 1, Shri Thakkar, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 2 & 3 and Shri Atteque, learned counsel for respondent No. 4.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, we prima facie find that none of the parties want cancellation of allotment of petrol pump. The contesting respondents claim their share and during arguments, we also found that the petitioners dispute this.

The dispute, if any, appears to be going on since the year 2006 and has seen the light of the day for the first time in the year 2014.

The parties, in this situation, agree that if a Mediator is permitted to go through the dispute, they will appear before the Mediator.

The office of Principal District Judge/ Authority under him, shall appoint a Mediator to mediate in the subject. The Mediator shall hold the proceedings, as far as possible at Malkapur.
